



# CROSS COMPETITION SANCTIONS

It is and has been a longstanding and accepted practice whereby players and officials, may be involved with more than one competition on in the same season.

While SANFL Juniors endorse this practice, players and officials must accept responsibility for their actions, and if found guilty and suspended for a breach of the rules/codes of behaviour of the game in one competition, they should serve a similar suspension in the other competition(s) in which they are involved.

The process will be guided by Rule 22.4 of the Laws of Australian Football; any deviation to the application of these sanctions will be at the sole discretion of SANFL Juniors.

For clarity, controlling bodies are defined by Rule 1.1 of the Laws of Australian Football.

This includes but may not be limited to;

- SANFL
- SACFL Leagues
  - Junior District Leagues
  - Adelaide Footy League
  - Regional Leagues
  - SAWFL
- School Sports Systems (e.g. SANFL Schools, School Sport SA)
- Representative Teams (State/Zone/District/Association)
