INTRODUCTION

The SANFL Schools Competition is a metropolitan based competition. Aimed at providing a fun, safe, inclusive, and introductory environment for all primary school children in years 2-7.

The competition will provide all participants an enjoyable and safe competition whilst at the same time enhancing their football and team skills.

2020 Competitions are open to all boys and girls with competitions provided in:

- Mixed Competitions Year levels 2/3, 3/4, 5/6 & 6/7.
- Female Competitions Year levels 2/3/4 & 5/6/7

During the nomination process, schools will be asked if they have an oval that can be utilised as well as be asked if the school would prefer a central venue or a home and away fixture. After nominations are collected SANFL staff will allocate schools to a competition based on these preferences and geographical location.

WHAT SANFL WILL PROVIDE

- Full competition administration
- Quality umpiring
- Season Fixturing of all matches
- 2x appropriately sized SANFL Club branded match balls for each team
- Wrist bands for all competing year 2/3 teams
- Online registration platform for participants to register
- Personal Injury Insurance for all participants

WHAT SCHOOLS WILL NEED TO PROVIDE

- Mouthguards (highly encouraged that each participant has their own mouthguard)

schools will be charged a once off fee of \$350 (excluding GST). The cost includes: SANFL administration costs, umpire costs, SANFL club branded match football, scorecards, competition wristbands (if required). SANFL will invoice schools by August 1, 2020.

Competition locations and grades are to be confirmed however it is subject to team nominations.

INSURANCE

SANFL want to provide a safe environment for all those involved. To do this SANFL are providing schools with compulsory Personal Injury Insurance at an additional cost of \$90.00 per 24 players (note: if a school was entering two 9-a-side teams, they would only be charged \$90.00).

Schools will automatically be billed and insured through the SANFL Marsh Player Insurance Scheme. SANFL does this to ensure that participants, coaches and spectators alike have an appropriate level of cover to avoid any financial burdens should an injury occur.

It should be noted that SANFL have received advice from DECD in relation to insurance and have confirmed the following:

- DECD does have a public liability insurance that extends to sporting activities, including the SANFL Schools Competition – this coverage is <u>limited</u>.
- This insurance, however, only protects against claims arising from negligence on the part of the department and will only cover the cost of ambulance attendance/transport for injured students.
- The insurance **DOES NOT** cover any medical or other expenses in relation to accidental injuries to the students, coaches and parents.

If a school can provide evidence that their own school has Personal Injury Insurance that covers their students adequately or to the equivalent of the existing Marsh Policy, they will forgo the insurance fee. Public Liability Insurances WILL NOT be accepted.

If your school has Personal Injury Insurance, please ensure that it covers after school and weekend activities. Then send the insurance certificate and a written confirmation of the school accepting responsibility of injuries and claims to your local Game Development Coordinator.
