GROUND ANNOUNCER SCRIPTS FOR VENUES

COMPLIANCE

All spectators have a personal responsibility to abide by COVIDSafe practices. Failure to follow instruction of COVID Marshals, club officials or security may result in eviction from the venue.

Stay safe and enjoy the game.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

While standing or seated, spectators must maintain 1.5m from others not in their household.

Please also ensure you remain a safe distance from all players and officials participating in the match.

GOOD HYGIENE

Please practise good hygiene by washing your hands frequently and covering your cough or sneeze.

If you visit a bathroom and there is no soap or hand drying tools, please let us know.

UNWELL

If you have any symptoms, including coughing, sneezing or fever, please advise a club official and follow their instruction. You may be asked to leave, encouraged to seek medical advice, and possibly undertake a COVID test.

COVIDSAFE CHECK IN

Don't forget to check-in using the QR Code at the ground today.

If someone in South Australia tests positive to COVID-19, the COVID Safe Check-In enables SA Health to quickly contact others who may have been exposed to the virus and stop the spread of COVID-19.
