## **“DID YOU KNOW” SANFL FACTS**

Originally formed as the South Australian Football Association on 30 April 1877, the SANFL (South Australian National Football League) is the oldest surviving football league of any code in Australia.

2021 marks the 141th season the Men's league has been played, this includes a 4 team merged competition for 3 years during World War II but not an unofficial Patriotic League held for 3 years during World War 1 was the competition was suspended.

Of all the state league's that have contained AFL reserves sides (SANFL, WAFL, VFL & NEAFL), the SANFL remains the only competition where an AFL reserves team has yet to win the premiership.

Last year saw the latest start (June 27th) and conclusion (October 18th) to a SANFL Season in its 144 year history.

The last 4 Grand Finalists (Glenelg & Port 2019, Eagles & North 2020) had not played finals the year before.

Of the 8 traditional SANFL clubs, all bar South Adelaide have played in a grand final in the last 11 seasons, and all bar South Adelaide have won a flag. The Panthers have finished 3rd twice (2014 & 2020) during that period. Adelaide is yet to win a SANFL flag and the Magpies have not won since 1999, the 2nd longest drought in the competition.

Defending premiers Woodville West Torrens are the only club to have won a premiership in each of the past 4 decades (1993, 2006, 2011 & 2020). In 30 seasons they have played in 11 Grand Finals and finished top three 18 times (60%).

Since moving back to Adelaide Oval in 2014, the last 6 Grand Finals have not been good for the favourites as the last six winners of the Second Semi Final (with a week off) have all lost the Grand Final. Eagles (2015 & 2016), Port (2017), Norwood (2018), Port (2019) & North (2020)

In the last 26 SANFL Grand Finals, the team leading at Three Quarter Time has gone onto win the premiership. The last team to trail at 3/4 time and win was Port over the Eagles in 1994.

The longest current head to head winning streak in SANFL is 11 games by Sturt over Central. The Bulldogs last defeated the Double Blues in August 2015. Sturt also hold a 10 game winnings streak over West

and Glenelg have won the last 8 over Adelaide.

The longest current head to head winning streak at a SANFL ground is 9 by Norwood over North at Coopers Stadium. The Roosters last won at the Parade in August 2009. 7 game winning streaks are held by South over Glenelg at Flinders University Stadium, South over North at Flinders University Stadium and Sturt over West at Unley.

Over the last 10 seasons (2011-20) 186 SANFL Men's players have been drafted or added to an AFL list. The Eagles led the way with 32 followed by Glenelg 29, Norwood 28, North 22, Sturt 21, South 17, West 14, Central 11, Port 9 and Adelaide 3.

Since 1877, Port Adelaide has won the most SANFL Men's league flags with 36, Norwood 30, Sturt 15, North 14, South 11. West & Central 9, Glenelg 5, Woodville West Torrens and West Torrens 4, Adelaide (not the current Crows) 1.

Combining Men's League, Reserves, Under 19, 18, 17 & 16 plus Women's league competitions, Norwood have the most premierships with 79 followed by Port on 73, North 47, Sturt 33, Glenelg 30, West Torrens 28, Central District 24, Woodville West Torrens 24, West 21, South 18, Woodville 7 and Adelaide (not the current Crows) 1.

The longest current Men's league premiership drought belongs to South Adelaide who last won the flag in 1964 (57 years), followed by Port Adelaide 1999 (22 years) and Central District 2010 (11 years).

The longest Grand Final drought also lies with South Adelaide who last played in 1979 (42 years), next followed by Central District who have not played in a Grand Final since 2011 (10 years), this after a Bulldogs run of 12 straight Grand Final appearances (2000-2011) all through a Second Semi Final victory.

The longest current Men's finals drought belongs to West Adelaide who have not played finals since their 2015 premiership, the next longest is Central District who last played finals in 2017. All other clubs played finals in either 2019 (Adelaide, Port, Norwood, Sturt), 2020 (South, Eagles, North) or both (Glenelg)

Glenelg is celebrating 100 years since its first SANFL league season in 1921. It's very first game was against West Adelaide as it will be in Round 1 this season.

## **“DID YOU KNOW” SANFL FACTS**

The Eagles either as West Torrens (1897-1990) or Woodville West Torrens (1991-) have never won back to back league premierships.

Adelaide returns for their 7th SANFL Season. Their overall record is 45-61-2 with 2 finals appearances both resulting in a Preliminary Final loss.

This year the Crows will have a list of 26 development players from 17 different suburban and country community clubs to “Top Up” their SANFL team as required.

The Port Magpies also return after missing 2020 due to AFL COVID-19 protocols. In their 6 seasons as the Power Reserves side, Port hold a 69-49-1 record, playing finals 4 times and losing 3 Grand Finals.

In their last SANFL season (2019) the Crows used 48 players, 34 on a AFL list whilst Port used 44 players, 35 on an AFL list.

In 2020, 293 players competed at SANFL Men's league level. Central used the most players 46, followed by Sturt 40, West 38, South and Norwood 35, Glenelg 34, Eagles 33 and North 32.

This year there are six new coaches in the SANFL compared with 2020.. Three of those have not coached in this league before (Paul Thomas—Central, Brett Hand—Glenelg & Jade Rawlings—Norwood) whilst three are returning to SANFL ranks (Mick Godden formerly Eagles now Adelaide, Brad Gotch formerly South now West and Martin Mattner returning to being in charge of Sturt).

With last years Grand Final coaches Jade Sheedy (Eagles) and Jacob Surjan (North) each entering their second season that leaves Matt Lokan (Port) entering his 3rd season and Jarrad Wright (South) his 4th as the two longest serving coaches in the league.

Glenelg's Liam McBean will be seeking to be the first player since Sturt's Brant Chambers (2007-09) to win a hat trick of Ken Farmer Medals as the league's leading goal kicker. Adam Richardson won the medal four years straight (1998-2001). Michael Wundke, Scott Hodges and Tim Evans have won the medal three times since its inception in 1981.

In 2020, McBean tied for the medal with the Eagles' James Rowe on 38 goals from the 14 round season, the first tie in the 40 year history of the award.

This medal is named after the all time SANFL leading goalkicker Ken Farmer who scored 1417 goals across 224 games (Average 6.3 goals per game) for North Adelaide, leading the league's goal kicking for 11 seasons,

These 1417 goals compare with the VFL/AFL record of 1360 by Tony Lockett in 281 games and the WAFL record of 1211 in 251 games by Subiaco's Austin Robertson Jr.

Victor Harbor Oval will host its first ever SANFL game in Round 14 when South host Adelaide.

Woodville West Torrens in it's 30 seasons have never had a Magarey Medalist nor “won” the wooden spoon.

West Adelaide is the only traditional SANFL club yet to win the Stanley H Lewis Memorial Trophy for best performed club across the Men's grades. It was first awarded in 1962.

Port Adelaide have won every SANFL award there is except one. No Magpie has yet won the Bob Quinn Medal for the best on ground in the ANZAC Day Game (Grand Final rematch). First awarded in 2002, it is ironic as Quinn played all his SANFL football at Alberton.

South are seeking their first consecutive finals series berth since 1991/92. (29 seasons). After only playing finals once (2006) in 18 seasons from 1993 to 2010, they have made the major round 5 times in the last 10 seasons.

The Magarey Medal is the oldest award of it's type in Australian Football, first won by Norwood's Alby Green in 1898. The WAFL Sandover Medal followed suit in 1921 and the VFL Brownlow Medal was not awarded until 1924, some 26 years later.

2020 Magarey Medal winner Campbell Combe was the 17th Rooster to claim the award.

Glenelg's Luke Partington was the last player to win a Magarey Medal and SANFL Premiership Medal in the same season (2019).

The SANFL will host the WAFL at Adelaide Oval in May with the past 2 encounters (2018 & 2019) won by the visiting side.

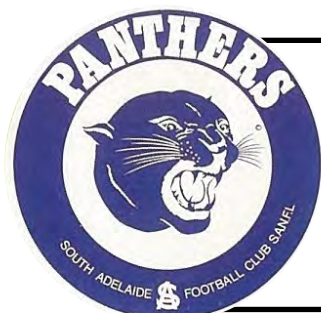

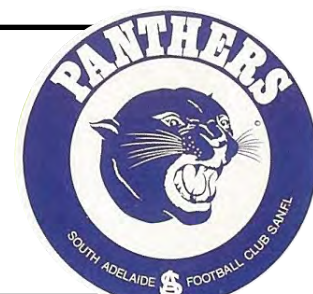
