INTRODUCTION

The AFL will introduce a new and innovative umpire technology offering from 2022.

This umpiring technology offering has been specifically designed to;

- 1. Reduce time spent on umpire administration and appointments
- 2. Increase accessibility to umpire training and accreditation
- 3. Improve umpire decision making capability through an interactive learning tool

This offering consists of three integrated platforms that are accessed via the OfficialsHQ gateway.



OFFICIALSHQ

OfficialsHQ is a custom-built umpire management system with powerful functionality. This functionality includes direct to umpire communication, auto-appointments, team affiliation information, an umpire feedback platform for coaching purposes, umpire payment, travel and expense deduction. OfficialsHQ also encompasses all match day paperwork requirements i.e., match conditions, umpire votes, notice of reports, incident referrals, environmental ratings plus much more.



The Umpire Learning Management System (LMS)

The umpire learning management system (LMS) is set to host 18 umpire and umpire coach certification and accreditation courses plus the Umpire Training Centre which contains 100+ umpire coaching resources and growing.

This is a move from the former 'set & forget' accreditation model to an ongoing education model. Umpires will be required to complete new learning module(s) each season, designed to keep all umpires current and updated.

This resource provides access to education to all umpires and is especially valuable to those umpires who are unable to attend local umpire training on a regular basis.

As OfficialsHQ and the umpire LMS is fully integrated, the umpire accreditation process now becomes automated which will significantly reduce administrative load for umpiring administrators.

Umpires Decision Making Tool

The AFL Umpires decision-making tool is a best-in-class application that is currently used to help develop the elite AFL Umpires decision making. Developed by Damian Farrow, a Professor in Skill Acquisition and current AFL Umpires Coaching & Innovations Manager, it is suitable for all umpires, regardless of level. This tool contains a 'Developing Understanding' mode for coaching and a 'Performance' mode – an interactive gamification mode to test an umpire's skill level. You can even test yourself against the umpire coaches!

This platform will be able to accommodate community football vision over time and will be available from early 2022.

OFFICIALSHQ FOR LEAGUE ADMINISTRATORS

OfficialsHQ is the one stop shop for all things umpiring. Umpires sign up, manage their appointments, availability, learning and umpire accreditations through the one platform. This also includes administrative functions that are required to be completed by umpires on match day.

OfficialsHQ integrates with PlayHQ to import details, including team sheets and player details that enables umpires to accurately complete match critical functions including best on ground votes and disciplinary processes including order off and notice of reports.

This offering provides access to the decision-making tool used by the AFL Umpires. Developed by a world leading expert in Skill Acquisition and current AFL Umpires Coaching & Innovations Manager Prof. Damian Farrow, it is suitable for all umpires, regardless of level. This tool contains a 'Developing Understanding' mode for coaching and a 'Performance' mode – an interactive gamification mode to test an umpire's skill level.

How are match day forms created?

Once you are setup as an OfficialsHQ user, you will have access to OfficialsHQ to configure your League's match day 'paperwork' (we have even created some templates as a starting point).

The great thing about matchday paperwork functions in OfficialsHQ is that all forms are fully customisable. If you need to add or amend match day paperwork forms, this can be done easily and in real-time.

Fields can be made conditional, so that when specific fields are completed or answered in a particular way, then auto-generated notifications can be sent to a designated email address(es). As a League Administrator you can have OfficialsHQ setup in such a way that you never miss a beat; anything from a late match start through to a red card - you choose!

It is important that League Administrators and Umpiring Administrators work closely to capture all their requirements in these forms. We want to make it as easy as possible for everyone to capture the important information they require.

How do I access completed match day forms?

Simply login to OfficialsHQ, click on 'Matchday Reports' and select the desired date range to export completed forms.

We know it can be a little frustrating when umpires don't submit their match day paperwork on time, so we have made it possible to create reminders to umpires to complete any outstanding forms. You can even set up forms so umpires will receive a post-match email every few hours until forms have been completed and submitted.

OFFICIALSHQ FOR CLUB-APPOINTED UMPIRES

We know Clubs have a lot happening on match day, so we want to make it as easy as possible for your Club-Appointed umpires to complete the required paperwork and get back to helping your Club.

Umpires (League-appointed or Club-Appointed) will be required to complete the match day paperwork via OfficialsHQ.

Clubs will be provided with a complimentary account to log in to OfficialsHQ to permit access to any match day paperwork that is required to be completed as directed by your League. If your Club has multiple Club-Appointed Umpires, they will all be able to log in to your Club's complimentary account to access any paperwork they need to complete for the games they umpire. Your Club-Appointed umpires will not need their own individual account (unless they wish to become officially accredited).

Prior to the commencement of the season, you will receive a communication from your League with details on how to login to OfficialsHQ and we recommend that your Club works closely with your League to ensure these login details are readily accessible to your Club-Appointed umpire.

It is recommended to print and laminate an A4 page clearly displaying the link app.officialshq.com or a QR code that directs to this link along with your Clubs' unique login details (username and password). Displaying this in your umpire's rooms ensures these details are readily accessible to your Club-Appointed umpires on match day.

OfficialsHQ is mobile device friendly, so we strongly recommend your Club-Appointed umpires complete any requirements immediately after the match.

The added benefit of utilising OfficialsHQ is that your Club-Appointed umpires will be able to access the umpire learning management system which provides access to the AFL's Umpire Training Centre; meaning your Club-Appointed umpires can develop their knowledge of umpiring throughout the season. They can even take the next step and become accredited should they wish to do so.
