\*\* At the conclusion of each minor round, umpires rate the behaviour of players, coaches and spectators for each game and age group. SANFL Juniors will calculate these scores together for all the clubs teams to determine the total combined average. For any combined average over 4.5, points will be awarded to the club. Additionally, if any individual club team scores a rating of 2 or lower, points will be deducted as part of this criteria. NOTE: For finals, no positive points will be awarded, however any ratings that are 2 or lower will still receive negative points.
