We are pleased to be able to provide an update on our successful transition to the new competition and registration platform, PlayHQ, and subsequently our new API links.

The new PlayHQ Media API is now live. As such, we would appreciate your support in helping us test the API's and ensure this is set up correctly and ready at your end to enable successful integration and reporting when competitions commence in Season 2022.

Through the API you will be able extract the data on demand, that is timely, relevant and accurate.

We will no longer be emailing Media Reports, so the successful set up of the API is essential to ensure the accurate reporting of clubs and participants results and achievements each week, noting this requires a level of technical experience and integration from your team to enable.

How do publishers get access to the Media API?

- a. Media publisher to make a request to use Media API via completion of request form [click here](#).
- b. PlayHQ will grant FLR API credentials to media publisher.
- c. Once received, the media publisher will be able to generate an authentication token.
