## SANFL SCHOOLS EXEMPTION FORM PLAYING UP

Players should only play up an age level when their physical capacity and social sense enables them to compete adequately at the higher age level and should be based on the advantage to be gained by the player, not just to make up numbers.

Players can play up one year level (e.g. eligible to play year 3/4 but wants to play year 5/6) without written consent.

If a player wishes to play up more than one age group (e.g., eligible to play year 2 but wants to play year 5/6) this form is required to be completed and returned to SANFL Schools.

If a year 1 student wishes to play in the SANFL Schools Competition, they must have completed at least 1 full season of Auskick & will only be eligible to play in a year 2 competition.
