GENERAL REMINDERS

cards/reports and forms

A reminder to all Umpires for the remainder of the season - if you do not give any cards during a game, you do not need to complete any card forms on Officials HQ. These are only to be completed and submitted when you do have any, and must be completed by the Field Umpire who gave the card/s.



Match Day & Training Venue Coaches will be supplied with cards if you do not have them.

Coach & Match Ratings

Everyone is reminded that we only require one set of ratings per game to be submitted. If you are running a game with 2 or 3 Field Umpires, you are only required to have one person send in the ratings. All Field Umpires must discuss the ratings after the conclusion of the match before being submitted.

Match day arrival times

Just a general reminder that umpires must arrive to their games with enough time to prepare, warm up (if older age group). We advise arrival to the field 15 minutes prior for non-premiership games and 20-25 mins for premiership grades

SANFL JUNIORS UMPIRING HUB

The Umpiring Hub serves as a comprehensive resource for all umpires throughout the season. Below is the set up of what the Junior Umpiring Hub looks like:



Within the hub, umpires can access essential information, including:

- Match Conditions
- Officials HQ Guides
- Administration Resources:
 - Procedures for game withdrawals
 - Reportable Offenses
 - Coach Ratings Guide

Match Conditions - It is important to read your Match Conditions Guide each week as you move between grades, in particular the Under 7 to Under 11 matches which have modified rules. Make sure we learn what a modified tackle is and know when Stealing and Smothering is not allowed.

Payments & Match Fees

Match fees are available on the Hub.

SANFL processes payments on a fortnightly basis. Next pay is due out this week from Wednesday 10th July. Please allow up to 3 business days for the funds to be processed.





Finals Appointments

TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS

We are excited to announce that we will be participating in the Tackle Your Feelings mental health education program. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for all Coaches, Players and Support Staff over the age of 16 years old.

All Football Clubs must create an environment that prioritises mental health, especially given the challenges we've faced in recent years. We are uniquely placed to recognise when one of our players is struggling, and this program will provide us with some tools to respond to this.

The details of the session are as follows, and I ask that you make yourself available to participate:

DATE: 17th of July TIME: 6.00 pm to 7.00 pm VENUE: The Chapel at Pulteney Campus.

More about the program

The program includes a workshop delivered by a local psychologist, plus online learning, and it aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players and support staff.

How to register

Coaches and support staff should register themselves via the Tackle Your Feelings website and they will then gain direct access to the online platform where they can book into one of the face-to-face workshops listed by clicking through an interactive map. They will also have access to the "Coaches Box", which is a library full of mental health resources for community coaches. Click on this link to watch a short video on how to register

STEPS:

Step 1 - Click "Create an Account" to set up your account on the Tackle Your Feelings website

Step 2 - Choose your state from the map

Step 3 - Find your club's session and click "sign up" to book in

Step 4 -- Attend a Tackle Your Feelings face-to-face workshop in your local region (90mins)

Step 5 - Once you've attended the workshop you then complete the Tackle Your Feelings online training -

choosing either the junior, youth or adult stream (3 x 20mins modules per stream)

Step 6 - Access resources and club rewards
