AFL Half Time - Grid Games

We are looking for nominations to umpire the AFL Half-Time Grid Games.

NEW Umpires can nominate and no experience is necessary.

It is an excellent experience umpiring on Adelaide Oval.

- Up to 6 field umpires are appointed to matches held at half time during AFL matches
- You will be advised Monday morning by email if you have been selected to umpire in the upcoming AFL round:
 - Meeting at Adelaide Oval approx. ONE hour before the AFL match start time
 - 4 tickets available ONE for you as umpire & THREE for family & friends
 (*subjecting to ticket availability. Umpires will receive a Minimum of 2 tickets)
 - AFL Umpire Uniform supplied for you to wear
 - You need to bring your own whistle
 - NO umpire payment
 - You must be registered with SANFL Juniors on Officials HQ to be able to be selected.

Coach Rating Matrix

Coach Ratings are an important part of supporting and providing a positive match day environment.

Umpires are required to complete a coach rating at the end of EVERY SANFL Juniors match. All scores are reviewed by Competition Management and any low scores, the appropriate action is taken.

All umpires are required to familiarise themselves with the requirements on how to give an accurate score for a coach's behaviour.
