ParkRun – 19th October and 9th November

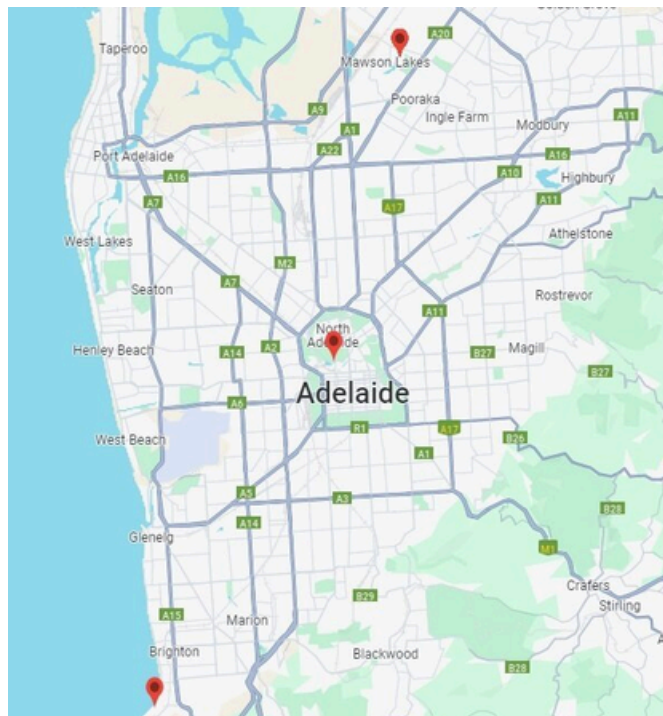
Join us for a fun 5km run at various ParkRun locations. All runs start at 8:00 am at the following locations:

REGISTRATIONS FOR 2025

Two Weeks to GO!

Registrations for the 2025 SANFL Juniors season begin from Friday 1st November (midday).

Prior to the day, a reminder email will go out to all of our Umpires from the 2024 season to provide information on what to do to re-register.

Some information has gone out about the new AFL-ID system, which links everything up including Officials HQ, AFL LMS, and Play HQ if you also play. This will be ready as part of registrations opening. Please keep an eye out on our communications before registering for the AFL-ID.



A few dot points to assist you early:

- You can also log in now to complete the 2025 LMS Education Module
- Make sure when you re-register that all details are correct. If you have changed address, phone numbers, or used a school email address that you can no longer check, this needs to be updated and advised.
- Remember when you select your disciplines (Field, Boundary or Goal Umpiring), that your first selection is deemed your first preference for the season.
- Don't forget, if you need to get an updated Working with Children Check, make sure you look into. You can apply for a new one inside 6 months of the end date of your current check. DHS are now sending emails to anyone who's WWCC is due to expire.

With over 900 Umpires registered for SANFL Juniors in 2024, the Umpiring team are keen to see as many of you as possible back for another season with big things planned!

With the end of the season in SANFL Juniors, some Umpires are continuing on as they head to the Pacific Cup, and also the NTFL.

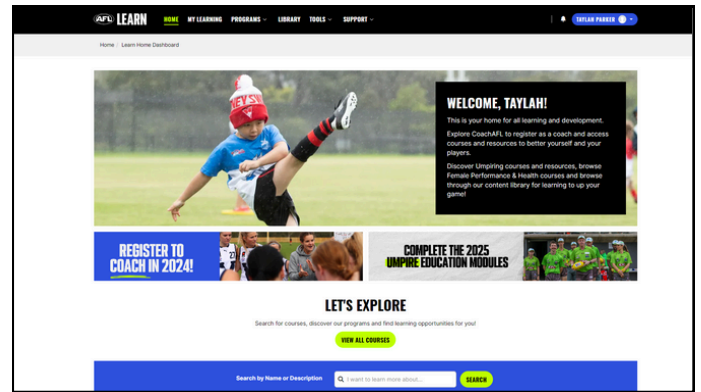
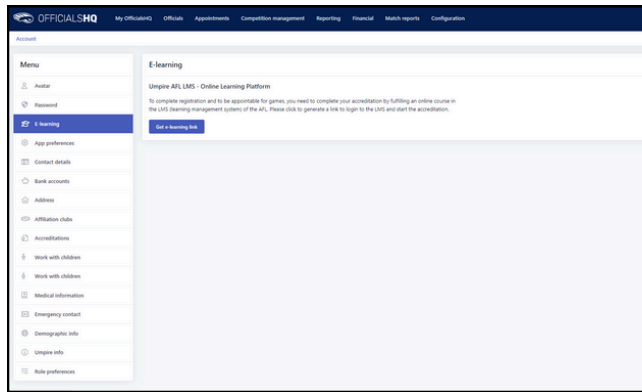

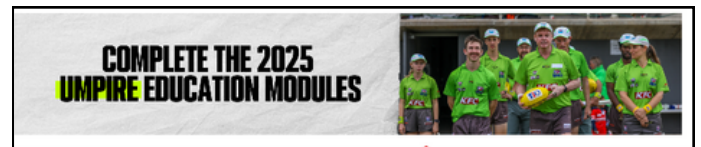
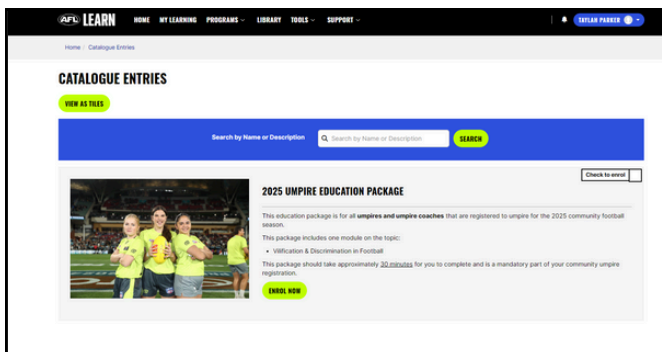
AFL LMS EDUCATION PORTAL

The Umpiring LMS is back for 2025. If you wish to umpire in 2025 you will be required to complete the LMS prior to being appointed to games.



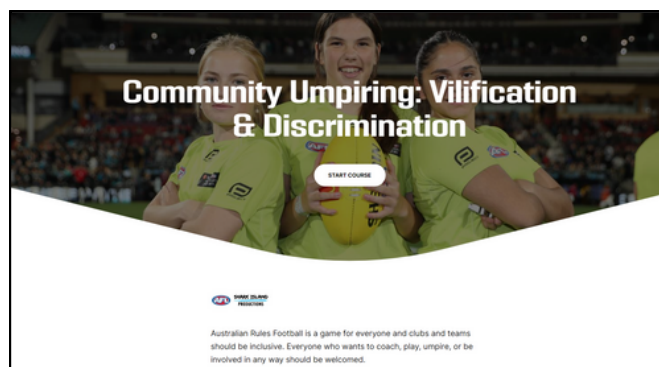
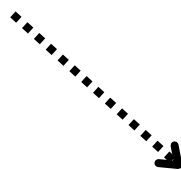
The LMS is accessible via Officials HQ, Log into your account and click on the profile icon. From here select account, then E-Learning. Select get E-Learning link which will generate a extra selection bar stating to go to E-learning portal.

You will be redirected to the AFL learn website. Click the Complete the 2025 Umpire education module on the right. As shown below.



Click and select Enrol now and then complete this course. This is shown below and is on vilification and discrimination.

Once completed, this will be added to your accreditations on Officials HQ

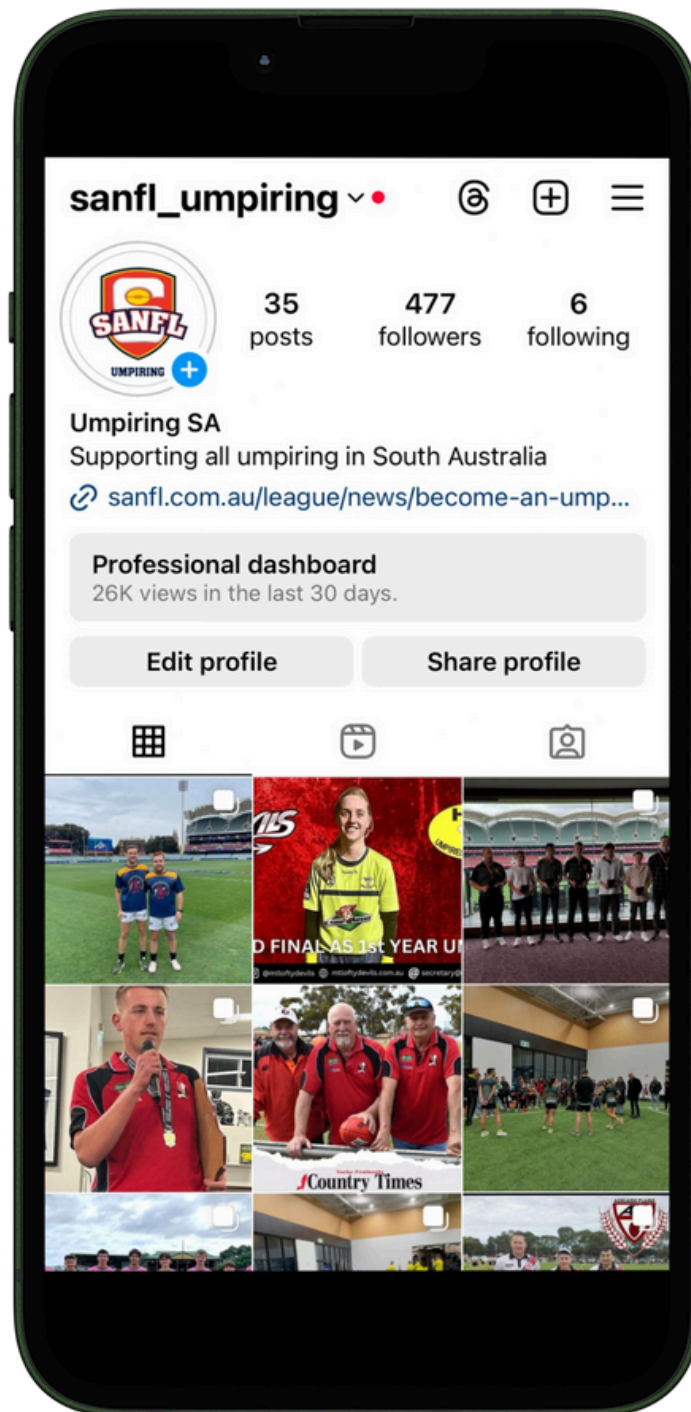
