In accordance with SACE Community Learning, SANFL has recognised Community Development programs which allow students the opportunity to achieve 10 SACE Credits at Stage 1.

To complete the recognised programs, students need to meet the following criteria:

- Complete the Online AFL Introductory Accreditation course and provide a certificate of completion.

- Demonstrate a commitment to umpiring by completing match-day appointments throughout the year in your chosen discipline.
- Throughout the season, attend physical training programs or seek further education opportunities through the completion of additional online AFL training courses or by receiving regular feedback from an umpiring mentor, to improve umpiring skills.
- Be observed in one match day environment and marked as competent by an approved Umpiring Coach, mentor or Coordinator in line with the Learning requirements checklist for your chosen discipline.
- Complete a Critical Thinking Reflection using the following template
