

# SECTION 1 – Who can talk to the Umpire any why?

Only the <u>Team Manager</u> from the participating SANFL Juniors teams can talk to an Umpire at a quarter break. An Umpire can be approached for the following reasons:

## SECTION 1 – Who can talk to an Umpire and why?

• Clarification of Match Conditions – Enquiry when there is a consistent change/failure to follow the prescribe Match

Conditions. **NOT** to query an umpiring decision or interpretation.

- Player Safety To address concerns of players safety in event of extreme weather or match/oval conditions ONLY.
- Clarification of Send Off/Reported Player Seeking clarification of the details surrounding a send-off or reported player

(i.e., what the sanction was for) and when the player can return to the field. **NOT** to argue or debate the decision of the umpire.

### SECTION 2 – The process of communicating with an umpire

**Step #1:** Team Manager is to approach to opposing Team Manager and advise them of intended communication with umpire. <u>Both Team Managers are **not** permitted to approach the Umpire together.</u>

Step #2: Team Manager is to approach the Umpire and introduce themselves using one of the statements from Section 3.

**Step #3:** Team Manager is to address their concern/query using the below statements in Section 3 (please have Match Conditions on hand with if applicable).

**Step #4:** Once addressed their concern/query, the Team Manager is to direct any further communications to their club delegate to refer to the SANFL Juniors Umpiring department.

Please Note:- If there is a SANFL Juniors Umpiring Coach present and speaking with the officiating umpires, then Team Managers are not permitted to approach umpires to allow for the umpires to receive necessary coaching.

### SECTION 3- Applicable Statements to communicate to an umpire which are to be strictly adhered to.

### • Clarification of Match Conditions

### SECTION 4- Failure to Adhere to Umpire Communication Framework

Failure to adhere to the framework will be treated as a serious infraction and can result in the following penalties to clubs;

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offence \$250 fine
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offence \$500 fine and potential loss of premiership points
- Further offences To be determined by SANFL Juniors Competition Management or Tribunal
