Introduction

The South Australian National Football League (SANFL) is proud to present an update on the SANFL Infrastructure Plan 2022-2032. This document reflects our ongoing commitment to ensuring football facilities across South Australia are welcoming, allow for venue capacity growth and increasing participation. It builds upon the groundwork laid by the 2022 plan, utilising the most recent data from 2023 facility audits and tracking our progress towards the ambitious goals set for 2032.

The SANFL Infrastructure Plan has been an evolving blueprint for the development of football infrastructure, with the 2022 plan providing a snapshot of facility provision at 2019 and setting the stage for subsequent updates. Since then, we have made substantial progress in enhancing our facilities, supporting player and volunteer participation, and engaging our communities. This 2024 update incorporates an assessment of target progress and reviews our achievements to date.

The main focus of this plan is the updated infrastructure data as reflected in the regional summaries. Facility development and provision have been tracked from 2019 to 2023 and shows the movement within the region and how it is tracking toward the 2032 targets.

The progression towards targets underscores our dedication to building contemporary and sustainable football infrastructure that also enables a future-ready football community in South Australia. By leveraging the latest facility data and continuously monitoring our progress towards the 2032 goals, we are well- positioned to achieve our vision.

O4 The state of facilities

The AFL's National Facility Audit program is conducted annually, providing an audit and refresh of data at every community football venue and their associated grounds in Australia. SANFL's latest audit insights (as at end 2023) are presented below and have been used to identify improvements, gaps, challenges and trends in our existing facility network across SA.


