

2021 WWTFC Senior Women's Development Coach

As a club we strive to develop the talent within our zone and work to provide opportunities for our players to compete at the highest level. We are looking for an experienced Development Coach to work alongside our Women's Head Coach Tess Baxter to facilitate the growth and development of identified players to strengthen pathways to AFLW.

The role would require the candidate to work directly with talent identified players in the WWTFC SANFLW program. Scope includes but is not limited to:

- Individual Developments Plans (IDP's) including Individual Goal Setting
- Personal performance reflection and evaluation through facilitated review sessions
- Development of football foundation skills in conjunction with Head Coach (kicking, handballs ground balls, contest work etc.)
- Understanding of Elite environments
- Playing a role within a team

The Development Coach will be required to possess the following skills and attributes:

- Strong communication skills
- High level of professionalism
- Understanding of AFL technical skills
- Ability to evaluate role within a game plan
- Experience in development in an AFL or professional setting
- Willingness to work collaboratively within our coaching team
- Ability to recognise and genuinely engage with all skill levels and personalities in a constructive and educational manner
- AFL Level 2 Coach (desired)

Commitment required – training once a week between November and February. Matches and 1 on 1 review sessions commence between February and April, all games to be watched in person or via HUDL.
