The cash prize will be spread throughout the minor round games and allocated to the purchasers of the best three (3) players in the League on the day and the best in the Reserves in accordance with match committee selections.

The cash prize for each will be calculated once both of the auctions have been completed and announced on the day

Prize money will be paid directly into the winner's bank account at the end of the season in one lump sum payment.
