WHAT IS THE PLAYER AUCTION

The WWTFC Player Auction provides the opportunity to bid on your favourite Player for a chance to receive a monetary return according to their performance throughout the 2025 SANFL season.

Thirteen (13) lots of players will be auctioned in the Main Player Auction and 17 lots in the Tender Auction.

The cash prize will be spread throughout the minor round games and allocated to the purchasers of the best two (2) players in the League both (Men's & Women's programs on the day), the best in the Development League (both Men's & Women's) and the best in the Wheelchair League in accordance with match committee selections.

The cash prize for each will be calculated once both of the auctions have been completed and announced on the day.

Prize money will be paid directly into the winner's bank account at the end of the season in one lump sum payment.

MAIN AUCTION

RULES & CONDITIONS

- 1. The Auctioneer will be in charge of the bidding and will decide any disputes.
- 2. All items are at the risk and expense of the purchaser on the fall of the hammer.
 - 3. Bids are to be made by raising your hand and calling an amount in excess of the previous bidder.

- 9. Full Payment is required before 10.30 pm Sat 1st Mar 25. **See Michelle Diamond to process payment**



the midfield.




#51 Max Litster

Always in the thick of the play Steve is one to watch with his movement around the court and his steady hands.




#17 Marlie Fiegert


#7 Maia Freemantle


#16 James Rowe


#19 Christina Leuzzi




#13 Brianna Walling


Brianna (Wally) is always a force on the field. This quiet achiever is a hard two way runner making sure she plays her role in defence and offence modes.

With a good pre season Pat is poised to take the next step in season 2025.




#8 Annie Falkenberg

Zac has spent the summer training across half back. His speed and appetite for the contest are traits that could see him become one of the best small defenders in the competition.




#25 Jordan Lukac

Olivia had an outstanding 2024 season before her injury. She has had a very solid pre-season and looking forward to once again taking the field and having an outstanding 2025 season.




#3 Kade Herbert
