CEO REPORT

As the 2025 season comes to a close, I would like to sincerely thank you for your continued support, patience, and belief in the Woodville West Torrens Football Club.

This year was not about chasing quick fixes or short-term wins. It was about doing the important work that often happens quietly, strengthening our foundations, lifting standards, and ensuring the Club is well positioned for long-term success.

Throughout 2025, our focus remained firmly on building a strong and connected football club. Our One Club, One Culture philosophy continued to guide everything we do, bringing together our men's, women's, wheelchair, junior, and community programs under one united identity.

Improving facilities for our players, staff, and members remained a key priority. One of the most significant projects progressed during the year was the Percy Fox Grandstand changeroom upgrade. This redevelopment is vital in providing safe, modern, and compliant facilities that meet the needs of all programs, particularly women's and junior football, and reflect the Club's long-standing commitment to player welfare, gender equity, and high standards.

I would like to acknowledge and thank the City of Charles Sturt for its ongoing engagement and support, and the SANFL for its assistance and collaboration in helping progress key infrastructure projects. These partnerships are important in delivering facilities that meet modern football and community expectations.

The Club also completed the installation of a new electronic scoreboard at Maughan Thiem Kia Oval. This will enhance the match-day experience and will be especially valuable with night football scheduled in 2026. It is a practical investment that benefits players, members, and supporters alike.

The Eagles Function Centre and Seven 22 continue to play a vital role in the overall health of the Club and remain the lifeblood of our finances. In December 2025, significant improvements began at Seven 22, marking the first major upgrades to the venue in more than 13 years. These works are focused on improving the bistro and gaming areas to ensure the venue remains contemporary, welcoming, and competitive in an increasingly challenging hospitality environment.

Strong performance from Seven 22 directly supports our football programs, facilities, and community initiatives. Investing in the venue is not about luxury; it is about protecting and growing the revenue base that allows the Club to operate sustainably. I would like to acknowledge the dedication and professionalism of the Seven 22 and Eagles Function Centre staff, whose efforts day in and day out underpin the success of these operations. In particular, I would like to recognise Sam Conlon and Vicki Wright for their leadership, commitment, and pride in ensuring these venues continue to perform strongly for the benefit of the Club.

On the field, there were many moments to celebrate. Our SANFLW program enjoyed a historic season, finishing as Minor Premiers for the first time and earning the opportunity to compete in the 2025 SANFLW Grand Final against South Adelaide. While the result did not fall our way on the day, reaching the Grand Final was a significant achievement and a strong reflection of the growth and professionalism within the program.

Our Wheelchair Football team delivered an outstanding year, finishing as Minor Premiers and then defeating Norwood in the Grand Final to secure back-to-back premierships. This achievement speaks volumes about the program's commitment, teamwork, and culture and remains a source of enormous pride for the entire Club. Like any season, 2025 also presented challenges. Injury management and player availability tested our men's program and, at times, impacted consistency and continuity. These challenges were addressed seriously by the Club.

In response, a thorough review of our high-performance, medical, and preparation systems was completed. As a result, changes have been implemented, targeted recruitment has taken place, and our overall structures have been strengthened. A strong focus has been placed on creating a high-performance environment and providing the best possible setting for our players to prepare, develop, and perform. We believe this work has positioned the Club well heading into the 2026 season.

Financial pressures across community sport remain a reality. Rising costs and increasing expectations mean every decision must be carefully considered. While we remain ambitious, we are equally committed to operating responsibly and sustainably to protect the long-term health of the Club. After a frustrating year with many injuries through all grades, we still had a lot of positives to take from the season. While our League team were hit excessively with injuries throughout the year, our Reserves and U18's made it through to the first week of the finals. Our women's team came from 7th in 2024 to finishing minor premiers in 2025. Our Wheelchair team went undefeated in their season and took out Back to Back premierships...a fantastic result from all involved.

Our Women's team continues to be well supported with many of our members paying \$25 on top of their existing Club membership fees to help assist with the running costs associated with putting the team on the field each week. After a wonderful season and finishing top at the end of the minor round, the girls fell just short in the grand final to a more experienced South Adelaide team. Senior Coach Narelle Smith has continued to see a vast improvement across all areas and was especially excited to see some of the upcoming talent that has been on show in our junior development teams.

We finished Season 2025 with 2230 members which is consistent with previous years. 



FINANCE REPORT

A combination of the current economic climate and the completion of the Barry Jarman Grandstand changerooms has certainly provided challenges for the entire Club. In 2025 the Club realised a combined loss of \$703,967 (surplus \$320,803 for 2024). The major variations between the 2025 and 2024 results is due to grants of \$555k received in 2024 for the changerooms and a reduction in gaming of \$433k in 2025. In 2025 the Club realised a consolidated cash loss of \$382,491 (consolidated cash loss of \$1,115,533 in 2024). .

FOOTBALL

The Football Club ended the year with a deficit of \$717,345 (a deficit of \$208,144 in 2024). As stated above the major differences are accounted for due to grant funding received in 2024 and the reduction in transfer of funds from Seven 22. The fact that the Club has achieved what it has within the current climate and still be in a stable financial position with which to start season 2026 is a testament to the staff led by David Couzner. David, along with the staff have made considerable sacrifices during the current financial year in order to meet the needs of players, members, sponsors and supporters. The Club certainly is incredibly fortunate in have these people working for us and for their continued and ongoing commitment to making our Club the best it possibly can be.

LICENSED CLUBS

The Licensed Clubs (Eagles Function Centre and Seven 22) realised a combined surplus of \$13,378 for 2025 (a deficit of \$112,659 for 2024). This was after transferring \$517,000 to the Football Club in 2025 compared to the transfer of \$701,000 in 2024.

Eagles Function Centre

The venue continues to attract a variety of private functions. The hard work of Sam Conlon and Kuyan Hedaux has resulted in a number of new functions being held at this venue throughout the year. Sam and his committed staff continue to encourage members to attend the venue on Thursday nights and match days. For the second year in a row the Function Centre has realised a surplus of \$24,456 in 2025 (\$36,980 for 2024). This is a testament to the magnificent work of Sam and his staff, servicing Club patrons as well as the general community.

Seven 22

Seven 22 realised a deficit of \$12,079 for 2025 (\$149,639 for 2024) after transferring \$517,000 to the Football Club to support the football programs. The returns from gaming have been a challenge during 2025 and resulted in a reduction of \$200k being transferred to the Football Club. 2026 will see the introduction of new gaming machines along with a revamp of the venue itself. Thanks to Vicki Wright, head chef Kuyan Hedaux and their staff for their hard work and commitment during the year.

Vicki Wright and her staff have been working tirelessly during the year keeping the venue fresh, updating and upgrading/changing necessary assets in order to continue to make the experience for the customers as inviting as possible.

To Melissa McKenzie and Michelle Diamond, a huge thank you, for always being willing and able to provide help and support whenever requested. In addition thanks to Anthony Marafioti for his extensive social media skills. I look forward to again working closely with you all in 2026.

The budgets for 2026 and beyond have been established to ensure that the Club once again realise profitability and cash surpluses, placing the Club in a strong financial position for the future.
